DRESS CODE

The following are the types of clothing that **cannot** be worn at AOD:

- Clothes with holes (pants with holes below the knees are allowed)
- See through clothing
- Leggings and jeggings
- Excessively baggy or tight clothing
- Mini skirts or short shorts (**Dollar Bill Rule**)
- Tube top; strapless dresses
- Shirts that expose the stomach
- Sleeveless shirts (shirts **must cover shoulders**)
- Hats, bandanas
- Items with suggestive or inappropriate words, pictures, symbols, alcohol or drug depictions

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED AT SCHOOL

- Skateboards/roller blades or shoes with rollers
- Toys such as water guns, squirt toys, whoopee cushions, playing or trading cards, yoyo's, etc.
- Harmful objects
- Objects that disrupt the learning environment
- Glass bottles or cans (no soft drinks)
- Obscene magazines, pictures, or literature
- Lighters or matches
- Cameras, video equipment, or recorders
- Personal items or clothing that advertise alcohol, tobacco, drugs, gangs, etc.
- Metal chains of any kind (belts or wallet chains)
- Laser pointers or lights

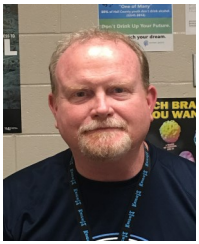
