# School Plan for Shared Student Achievement Academies of Discovery @ South Hall

What is it? This is a plan that describes how The Academies of Discovery @ South Hall will provide opportunities to improve family engagement to support student learning. Academies of Discovery @ South Hall values the contributions and involvement of parents and family members in order to establish an equal partnership for the common goal of improving student achievement. We also distribute an annual survey for their suggestions on the plan and the use of funds for family engagement. Parents and family members can also give feedback during our annual community session with school leaders to revise the plan for the upcoming school year.

**Who is it for?** All students participating in the Title I, Part A program, and their families, are encouraged and invited to fully participate in the opportunities described in this plan. The Academies of Discovery @ South Hall Middle will provide full opportunity for the participation of parents with limited English, parents with disabilities, and parents of migratory children.

Where is it available? At the beginning of the year, after revision, the plan is posted on the school's website, presented at the Annual Title I meeting, and sent home via Infinite Campus to all parents after it is approved. Copies are also available in the school's front office.

#### **District Goals**

- 1.By the end of FY22, the percentage of students in each subgroup moving into the "Proficient" and "Distinguished" levels of performance on the Georgia Milestone Assessments will increase by 2% in the "Proficient" and "Distinguished" levels of performance.
- 2. By the end of FY23, the percentage of students in each subgroup meeting "Proficient" levels of performance on local assessments will increase by 2%.
- 3.Increase the percentage of referred students who access schoolbased mental health services by 2% each year (with FY21 being the baseline year).

#### 2021-2022 School Goals

By the end of FY'22, the percentage of students moving up a performance level on the common local in Language Arts and Math will increase by 2% (with FY 21 being a baseline year).

By the end of FY '22, 100% of students will self-monitor their progress, in order to increase student efficacy and increase academic growth.

By the end of FY'22, every student will report having a trusted adult they can rely upon in the school building.

By the end of FY'22, increase the number of students achieving proficient or distinguished learner status on standardized assessments by continuing to practice reflective and research-based strategies (Marzano's high yield strategies and lesson components).

### School-Parent Compacts

As part of this plan, Academies of Discovery @ South Hall and our families will develop a schoolparent compact, which is an agreement that parents, teachers, and students will develop together that explains how parents and teachers will work together to make sure all our students reach grade-level standards. The compacts will be reviewed and updated annually based on feedback from parents, students and teachers during the first Parent Input meeting. The school-parent-student compacts are kept in the Front Office, and a digital copy posted on the school website.
