What is Title I?

The Academies of Discovery @ South Hall is identified as a Title I school as part of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). Title I is designed to support State and local school reform efforts tied to challenging State academic standards in order to reinforce and enhance efforts to improve teaching and learning for students. Title I programs must be based on effective means of improving student achievement and include strategies to support parental involvement. What is it? This is a plan that describes how The Academies of Discovery @ South Hall will provide opportunities to improve family engagement to support student learning. Academies of Discovery @ South Hall values the contributions and involvement of parents and family members in order to establish an equal partnership for the common goal of improving student achievement. This plan describes the different ways that The Academies of Discovery @ South Hall Middle will support family engagement and how families can help plan and participate in activities and events to promote student learning at school and at home.

How is it revised? The Academies of Discovery @ South Hall invites all parents to attend an annual parent and family engagement input meeting in the spring to review and revise this parent and family engagement policy, as well as the school/district consolidated needs assessment, school/district improvement plans, school-parent compact, and the parent and family engagement budget. The Academies of Discovery @ South Hall Middle welcomes parent input and comments at any time regarding the plan. All parent feedback will be used to revise the plan. The plan is posted on our school website for parents to view and post feedback throughout the year. We also distribute an annual survey for their suggestions on the plan and the use of funds for family engagement. Parents and family members can also give feedback during our annual community session with school leaders to revise the plan for the upcoming school year.

Who is it for? All students participating in the Title I, Part A program, and their families, are encouraged and invited to fully participate in the opportunities described in this plan. The Academies of Discovery @ South Hall Middle will provide full opportunity for the participation of parents with limited English, parents with disabilities, and parents of migratory children.

Where is it available? At the beginning of the year, after revision, the plan is posted on the school's website, presented at the Annual Title I meeting, and sent home via Infinite Campus to all parents after it is approved. Copies are also available in the school's front office.

2022-2023 District Goals

- 1. Goal 1: By the end of FY23, the percentage of students in each subgroup moving into the "Proficient" and "Distinguished" levels of performance on the Georgia Milestones Assessments will increase by 2% in the "Proficient" and "Distinguished" levels of performance.**
- 2. Goal 2: Increase the percentage of referred students who access school-based mental health services by 2% each year (with FY21 being the baseline year) to decrease the number of OSS days in grades 6-12.**

2022-2023 School Goals

- 1. By the end of FY'2022-23, the percentage of students in each subgroup moving up a performance level on the Georgia Milestones Assessments will increase by 2% (with FY'22 being a baseline year).**
- 2. By the end of FY'23, the number of students with 10 or more absences and/or 3 or more discipline referrals will decrease by 10% through intentional collaborative planning and progress monitoring focused on authentic intellectual work, healthy mindsets and relationships, and increasing student engagement and enjoyment.**

School-Parent Compacts

As part of this plan, Academies of Discovery @ South Hall and our families will develop a school-parent compact, which is an agreement that parents, teachers, and students will develop together that explains how parents and teachers will work together to make sure all our students reach grade-level standards. The compacts will be reviewed and updated annually based on feedback from parents, students and teachers during the first Parent Input meeting. The school-parent-student compacts are kept in the Front Office, and a digital copy posted on the school website.
